1st trimester

1st month (2 to 6 WA)

- **Pregnancy test**

2nd month (7 to 10 WA)

- **Appointment with the gynaecologist** to confirm the pregnancy

- The law does not specify when you must inform your employer. This can be done at the beginning of the pregnancy or at a later stage

3rd month (11 to 15 WA)

- **1st prenatal examination**
- **Ultrasound** of the 1st trimester (around 12th week)
- Prenatal screening test for trisomy: **Non-invasive prenatal test (NIPT)**. This test can be carried out from 10 weeks of amenorrhoea, after the first ultrasound scan

2nd trimester

4th month (16 to 19 WA)

- **2nd prenatal examination**

5th month (20 to 24 WA)

- **Morphological ultrasound** (between 20 and 24 weeks)

- If you wish to take **parental leave**, you must submit an application

6th month (25 to 28 WA)

- **3rd prenatal examination**
- **Screening test for gestational diabetes:** carried out between the 24th and 28th week of pregnancy

Third trimester

7th month (29 to 32 WA)

- Send the medical certificate stating the expected date of delivery to the CNS and your employer (must be issued within the last 12 weeks of pregnancy)
- Start of **prenatal leave**

8th month (33 to 36 WA)

- **4th prenatal examination**
- **3rd ultrasound** (between 32 and 34 weeks)

9th month (37 to 41 WA)

- **5th prenatal examination**
- **Streptococcus B screening test:** carried out around the 36th week
- Send the prenatal allowance application form to the CAE

Birth

- **Registration of the baby** within 10 calendar days of birth
- Send the birth allowance application form and the family allowance application form to the CAE.
- Start of 12-week **postnatal leave**
- 10-day **paternity leave**

2 years later

- Send the post-natal allowance application form to the CAE
